

A Message for the Chairman of the Board

Dear Friends:

What another great year! Fairfield County College Bound continues to provide college access services to individuals in Lancaster and Fairfield County in an effort to ensure that our students have the wherewithal to enroll in, and thrive in, college.

The community need for college attainment is great. The Lumina Foundation estimates that 64 percent of Ohio jobs will require a postsecondary credential by 2020. Ohio is the seventh largest state, yet it ranks 36th in educational attainment. Currently, around 26% percent of adults 25 and over in Fairfield County have a Bachelors degree of higher. To meet this critical need, FCCB provides individual advising and special events to help students of all ages make smart choices about postsecondary education and to ensure that they have the resources needed to succeed.

We cannot do this in a vacuum. It is important to remember that it takes the community as a whole to recognize its responsibility to make sure that students get to and through college. On the next page, you will see in more detail how Lancaster and Fairfield County is stepping up to support students through the college-going process.

In Calendar Year 2015, FCCB developed new partnerships while deepening existing ones to move us closer to our goal of driving our community forward by increasing college attainment. One great advancement this year was the addition of Berne Union High School. In September, FCCB began offering college access services to BU, and soon after, a very generous business from the community came forward with an offer to underwrite expenses for BU into the future. Working toward innovative partnerships and increasing locations of service will remain a priority in 2016.

As always, we are deeply appreciative of all of our partners, and we look forward to our continued partnership as we work to assist Fairfield County residents in understanding the value of higher education while linking them with resources and opportunities to access and pursue it.
